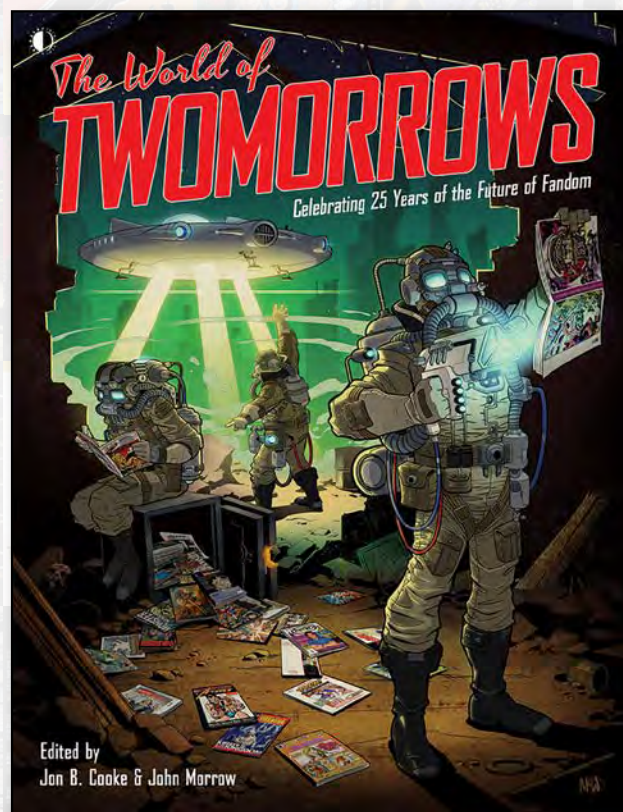

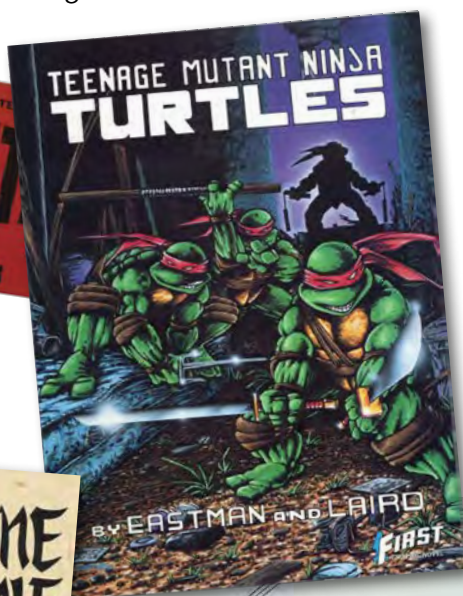

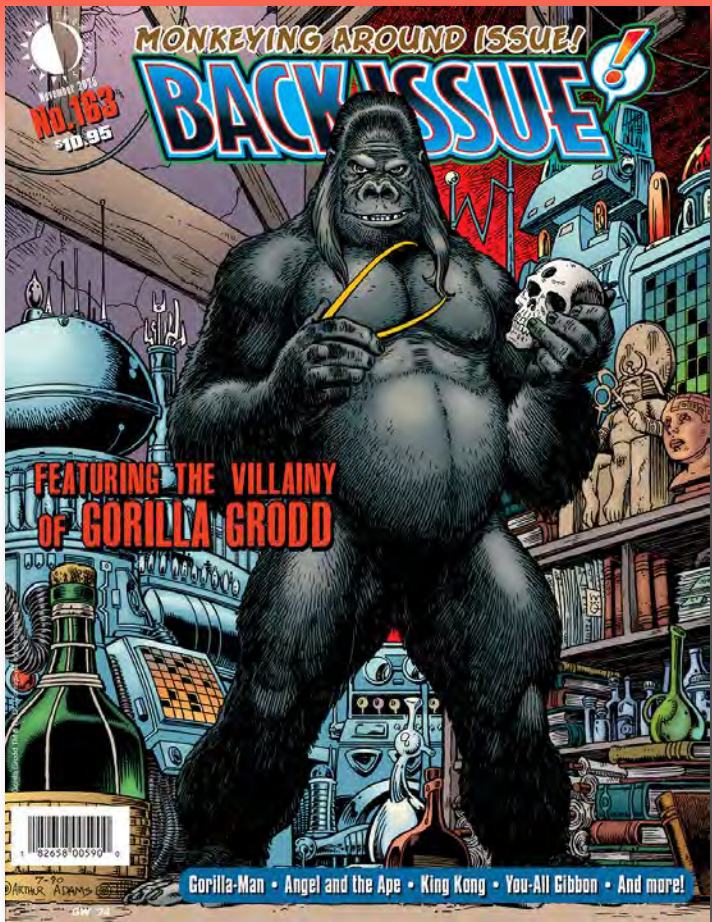

From a modest promotional comic hawking theater subscriptions, First blossomed into an aggressive imprint with achievements that included adapting the fabled sci-fi play *Warp*; reviving beloved '70s Charlton hero *E-Man*; luring **MIKE GRELL** over from Pacific Comics to continue *Starslayer* and launch *Jon Sable, Freelance*; and releasing one of the '80s greatest comic book series, *American Flagg!* by **HOWARD CHAYKIN**. Soon followed *Elric*, *Grimjack*, *Nexus*, *Shatter*, *Dreadstar*, *Lone Wolf and Cub*, super-hero *Alter Ego*, and a resurrection of *Classics Illustrated*. Featuring the recollections of founders **MIKE GOLD**, **JOE STATON**, and dozens more, this book continues **JON B. COOKE** and **RICHARD J.
